Title: Predictive molecular markers of chemoradiation resistance in cervical cancer.

Background: Cervical cancer continues to be a significant cause of morbidity and mortality in our patients with about 1.25 lakhs new cases and 78 thousand deaths every year as per GLOBOCON 2020 data. Most of these patients present in a locally advanced stage, where radiation along with concurrent low dose chemotherapy is the standard treatment. Survival of these patients strongly depends on how the disease responds to the chemoradiotherapy. In spite of recent advances in various treatment modalities, the overall cure rate of cervical cancer patients continues to be around 60 - 70% with a poor prognosis for the remaining 30-40% patients. Heterogenous treatment response demands profiling of each patient, hence biomarkers- based treatment selection of right cohort is a strong tool for personalized treatment. Therapy resistance occur due to multifactorial events and targeting key molecules involved in treatment resistance could combat treatment resistance. Herein, we profiled both the global proteomic and phosphoproteomic landscape of the concurrent chemotherapy resistant cervical cancer to identify potential predictive biomarkers as well as therapeutic targets.

Methods: We employed mass spectrometry based global proteomic and phosphoproteomic strategies to identify proteomic signature and dysregulated kinase involved in CCRT resistance. The biopsy tissue samples were collected before the start of the therapy and the protein was extracted, digested from each sample and labelled with 10 plex TMT (Tandem Mass Tags). The pooled peptides were fractionated by basic pH liquid chromatography analyzed on Orbitrap-Fusion-Tribrid mass spectrometer (ThermoFisher Scientific). For the phosphoproteomic experiment, the peptides were enriched using IMAC based phosphopeptide enrichment method. Liquid chromatography-mass spectrometry/ experiments together with thorough bioinformatics analysis were carried out to characterize the global proteome and phosphoproteome.

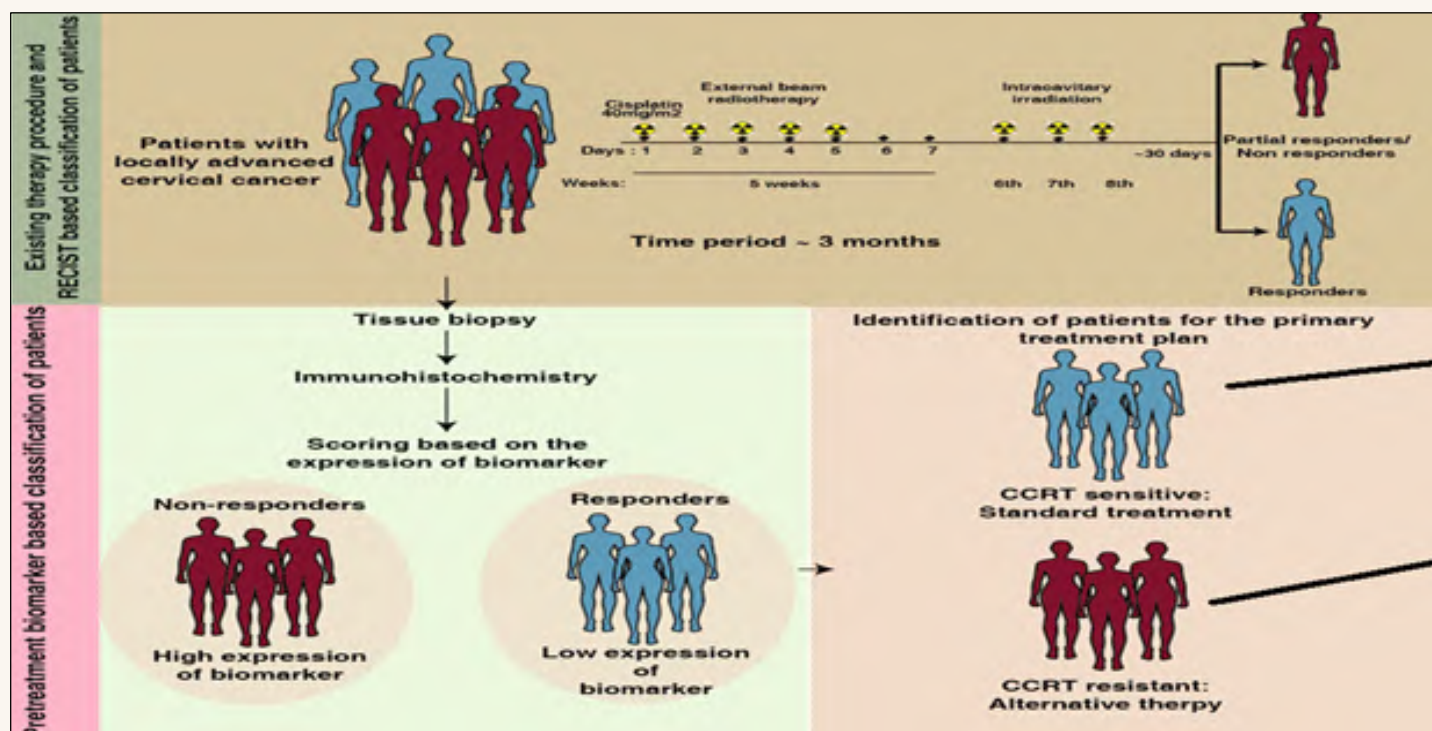
Results: Analysis of protein expression and phosphorylation led to the identification of dysregulated protein expression and phosphorylation between treatment sensitive and resistant patient cohorts. Further analysis and validation experiment revealed the potential of differentially expressed protein syntaxin 3 (STX3) as a predictive biomarker for treatment resistance.

Write-up

Phosphoproteomic analysis revealed the enrichment of DNA repair pathway in treatment-resistant cohort and the phosphorylation of the proteins involved in DNA repair such as SMC1A, HMG1, MGMT, DDB2, MSH6 are dysregulated between the cohort suggesting role of DNA repair pathway in the treatment resistance. Kinase-substrate enrichment analysis revealed the activation of kinases such as CSNK2A1, PRKDC, PLK1, NEK2 and ATM in non-responders.

Conclusions: We have identified an accurate and reliable biomarker STX3 to predict CCRT resistance in cervical cancer. This discovery will enable the treating oncologist to choose an alternative therapy early which might lead to an increase in the chance of survival in these patients. Further, it will also benefit the patients by reducing the cost, time and toxicities of futile treatment. Further, the phosphoproteomic profiling revealed dysregulation of DNA repair pathways which may be involved in treatment resistance. Targeting the activated kinases such as CSNK2A1, PRKDC, PLK1, NEK2 and ATM could combat treatment resistance in cervical cancer patients.

ISO EC Meeting, 3rd November 2023 | 08:00 AM

Venue: Jio Convention Centre, Mumbai

1. The meeting was called to order by the President ISO, Dr. Ramesh Bilimagga.
2. The Treasurer Report was presented by the Treasurer ISO, Dr. Tanveer Majeed and was unanimously passed.

The theme of the conference was "Demystifying the new normal in Cancer Care" The conference was hugely successful with a high-quality Scientific program that was critically acclaimed by one and all and a record participation of over 1270 Faculty and Delegates. The interactive teaching workshops included Workshops on Radiotherapy, Lymphoma, Onco-Rehabilitation, Onco-Nutrition, Psycho Oncology, Chemo Radiation, Communication Skills, Surgical Skills, Dysphagia management among others. The regular scientific program included didactic lectures, interactive panel discussions, debates on the latest developments in the management of the most prevalent cancers in India. Addition of an attractive Daily Bumper Quiz and a Grand Student Quiz with a latest electronic gadget mobile phones and exciting cash prizes respectively sparked a great deal of enthusiasm from all the Faculty and Delegates.

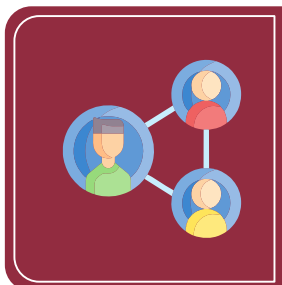
